We also collected for the Foodbank to help a local charity, as well as the Junior Diabetes Research Foundation (a charity close to the heart of one of our children).

In school, our Y6 children learnt about Nelson Mandela and how he challenged injustice in South Africa.

Our extra-curricular clubs are up-and-running and we have enjoyed sporting success in a variety of different areas. Our Y1/2 children won the multi-skills event at Carnforth High School, our Y5/6 athletes won the indoor athletics at Lancaster and Morecambe College and our Y5/6 korfballers won the korfball tournament at Trumacar. We are also keen on participation, as well as competitiveness and virtually all of our Y6 children have represented the school at sport this year. We also got involved in the #Letgirlsplay initiative which saw our Y6 children setting up activities for a massive girls football event on the school field.

Our Y6 children have been climbing and abseiling, facing their fears to go backwards down a cliff - wow! Our Y3 children went canoeing and worked super hard to make progress in the face of 25mph winds!

We are slowly getting back to normal in school and are holding Easter bingo for the children where they can win Easter eggs amongst other prizes. We will be holding our Easter service at St Paul's Church with all children participating. Monday 14 March saw the beginning of our Science week, with the theme of growth and sustainability, ending in an exhibition for parents on the Friday.

We are also taking part in the Big Wheel and Pedal from wb 21.3.22 where we will be encouraging our children to walk, scoot or cycle to school to help save the environment. A busy few weeks in school!!

CATON PRIMARY SCHOOL

What a fantastic day we had to celebrate World Book Day! Class 1 started their day by reading 'Would You Eat Candy without Me?' by Draga Jenny Malesevic and then created their own candy bar that they would share with a family member - there was even a chocolate fountain involved! Class 2 and 3 watched one of the World Book Day 'live events', hosted by a range of authors, illustrators and some of the cast of 'Matilda the Musical'. They then imagined turning one of their favourite films/TV programmes into a book and designed the front cover. As if that wasn't enough fun, we managed to squeeze in a costume parade, took some time to read with children from other classes and finished the day by snuggling down with our parents and reading a story.

Science week was a great success. Our families had fun, out and about, spotting and taking photographs of science in everyday life. In school, the children learnt all about careers involving science, from neuroscientists, polar scientists and deep sea ecologists to engineers and veterinary surgeons.

Educating children and informing parents about online safety continues to be a high priority and so we were delighted that so many families attended our online safety workshop for parents, run by a Lancashire County Council consultant.

Our value of the month for March was equality and the children gave much thought to many issues involving diversity and human rights. Class 3 gained so much from their trip to the slavery museum in Liverpool to complement their learning in history and the whole school response to the Caton Ukrainian appeal was phenomenal. We are a small school but our families have very big hearts.
