LUNE VALLEY SWIFT GROUP

A big positive for our group this year has been the number of people becoming involved in initiatives to help our breeding Swifts, such as by sending us their sightings or installing nest boxes on their houses. It's been fantastic to welcome new group members and expand our volunteer network.

Thanks to the Champion Bowland fund, this year we have been able to install 15 Swift nest boxes on community buildings (Caton Institute and Methodist Church) and private houses in Caton and Brookhouse, and we hope more will go up over the winter. We have also been able to produce an advice leaflet to help homeowners encourage and protect nesting Swifts.

Our Swifts will by now have completed their 6000-mile migration to southern Africa; the fledglings leaving nests here may now remain on the wing for up to 3 years, returning each May to the Lune valley, but only landing again when they too are ready to breed. These amazing birds have been declining, but there is a lot we can do to help reverse this and secure their future as a part of our summer.

We've had a really exciting month at Caton St Paul's CE Primary School.

Our Year 3 children have enjoyed canoeing on the canal at Borwick, as well as toasting marshmallows round a fire. They had a fantastic time and everyone managed to stay dry! Our Year 4 children had a wonderful day out: a full itinerary of ghyll scrambling, rock climbing and caving meant they were all exhausted by the time they returned. Our commitment to outdoor education remains strong, even at this difficult time. We are currently organising outdoor experiences for Reception and Years 1,2 and 5. The Y6 residential at Robin Wood is booked for July.

We celebrated remembrance day in school with a special worship that was enjoyed by all bubbles. All children and staff contributed to a remembrance day video that can be seen on Facebook - tissues at the ready. Our Wraparound Care Club coordinated the remembrance day display which can be seen on the grass at the front of school.

The Art competition was popular with over 60 entries: our panel of expert judges had a difficult time choosing a KS1 and a KS2 winner - well done to all who took part. We held a mufti-day to raise money for Children in Need and are still collecting items for shoeboxes to be sent to disadvantaged children abroad.

As we gear up towards Christmas, we are making plans for an alternative nativity that can be sent to parents to watch digitally - watch this space.

It was great to be able to hold virtual parents' evenings via zoom - another example of how we have managed to try and keep things as normal as possible for children, parents and the community.

Despite the difficult times that we find ourselves in, we are still managing to connect with the community. Thank you to Alan Wadsworth for his super 'Zoom' assembly all about courage. We certainly all need plenty of that at the moment! Children In Need day was a great success. Through a variety of games, competitions and a sponsored Joe Wicks exercise session, we raised a huge total of £300. Thank you to all our families and members of the wider community who supported us.

On Remembrance Day, we learnt about the service and sacrifice made by those in the past and present and, following a two minute silence, each child placed a poppy in the ground by the school entrance to make a lovely display of remembrance.

We are pleased that we have been able to continue to teach a broad and balanced curriculum throughout the autumn term, with minimal disruption. Class 2 have been learning all about the United Kingdom and the human body, whilst Class 1 have been learning about continents, seas, habitats and the work of David Attenborough. The whole school has also studied Diwali. Swimming has continued for the juniors and Covid certainly isn't stopping us from producing our annual nativity in Class 1 which will be filmed in the final week of term. We are looking forward to our Geography Mastermind competition in early December (we have the chair at the ready!) in which children from age 4 to 11 will compete for the coveted title as well as our family winter poetry competition.

LUNE VALLEY SWIMMING POOL - UPDATE.DECEMBER & JANUARY.

Unfortunately, in line with Government policy, in November we had to close the pool to the general public... We were however able to remain open for organised school sessions in line with current guidance and therefore still able to welcome local children. As we go to press we hope to re-open, subject to national regulations from December 2nd...

As reported previously; the pool has been extremely well supported by the local community since the initial lockdown period with record numbers of individuals using the facilities. The second lockdown was therefore unfortunate but we aim to utilise the enforced hiatus to good effect by replacing the aged boiler utilising part of the National Community lottery grant of almost $\pm 30,000$. We plan to have the new boiler installed along with other minor works whilst we are closed to the public - dependent upon availability -and are hopeful that all this can be achieved in order to minimise disruption to our public programme.

The Community lottery support will also assist us in alleviating the additional costs associated with the shutdown periods and with running the pool at reduced capacity in-between the periods of closure.

We will continue to update the website to advise of revised operating guidelines and the new timetables and once we are allowed to re-open we will accept bookings. Remember to please book in advance because numbers will still be limited and some sessions over-subscribed.

On behalf of the Trustees, staff and all the team at the Lunesdale Swimming pool we would like to thank all our supporters, volunteers and friends and wish you a most peaceful, happy and safe Christmas as current conditions allow. Well, Whew! What a relief our iconic owl survived the diggers crushers and earthmovers ... and has emerged clean and watchful. And no longer is the Play Park quite the haven for the slugs and other wildlife and mysterious plants that have encroached during the years since Jeff, our lengthsman, left and maintenance became too much for the kind informal voluntary helpers. Long may regular maintenance continue.

But wait... there is a rumour that our owl loves all the children and families who visit and is very protective of the wonderful play experience they enjoy from the award winning design... and at night, our owl awakes to pursue anyone who has made the fatal mistake of harming the design...

An aerial image, which you can see on our facebook page, shows the extent of damage. Most striking is the removal, rather than the renovation of Woodhenge, that favourite climbing challenge for older kids, aspiration for younger ones. And a symbol of the soaring moor and peatland of the Forest of Bowland, our Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. Restoring Woodhenge would be easy. Please, may we get on with it? Then from either side of Owl, the stepping stones have been removed, and the curved wooden path with its bouncy sound boards. Surely, these play benefits must be restored?

Then there is the question of where are the replacement for the community fruit trees which were integral to funding awards. If replanted promptly they would have yielded loads of lockdown community fruit - and the kids loved them anyway.
