#### Parish Clerk: New Clerk Needed

The Parish Council needs a new Parish Clerk, as Gill Mason is standing down shortly. This is a part-time post, which can be done mainly working from home. Attendance is expected at the monthly Parish Council meeting (second Tuesday evening of each month apart from August). The work is primarily administrative, including minuting meetings and correspondence. The Clerk is also our Responsible Financial Officer, setting up online bank payments and keeping payment records. An excellent post for someone who would like to be involved with their local community. There is some flexibility on hours and salary, but over £800 a month for up to 14 hours a week work. We are happy to consider people who have transferable experience in other workplace settings, as mentoring and training in local authority administration is available. **Budget** The Parish Council has drafted a budget for 2024/25. Changes include paying for more frequent mowing at Fell View Play Park and the playing fields there, and money for regular maintenance of the Play Park as volunteer commitment alone is not enough. This year we really hope to purchase solar-powered Speed Indicator Devices (SPIDs) to help road safety. We will decide in January how much the Parish Precept for 2024/25 will be.

**Poors Land** The Parish Council has made ten grants to residents out of the income from the Poors Land Charity. Caton Greenway improvements We hope that the additional benches and planting planned for the Greenway will take place early in 2024. It has taken a while to find contractors able to take on the work.

**Fell View Play Park** A big Thank you to Caton Gala for their donation of £100 towards the Play Park renovation. We are awaiting confirmation that our bid to the Lancashire Environment Fund has been successful.

We are now looking for a contractor to carry out landscaping work at the play park early in 2024. Tasks include:

- 1. Resurfacing and reseeding under the zipwire and in the goal mouth
- 2. Replacing existing wooden fence posts and retaining posts with recycled plastic sleepers
- 3. Replacing wooden ground-level edging with recycled plastic edging.

# Improvements to the Greenway in Caton

The Sustrans project to improve the Greenway is now partially completed. Before the Christmas holidays the majority of the works were completed. Residents will notice enhancements to the route including safety improvements where the Greenway crosses Station Road, refreshed surfacing, widened access points, enhanced signage and more.

Sustrans will be returning to site in early January to complete the project by undertaking works to the Bull Beck access ramp. A much smaller closure of the Greenway from Holme Lane heading east will be in place for approximately 3 weeks while these works are completed. Sustrans sincerely apologise for any inconvenience this may cause.

The project is also looking to engage with the local community to encourage more walking, cycling, and wheeling. Sustrans are arranging a free, fun event day on the path in February which may include activities such as a nature trail for kids and parents and the opportunity to have a go on our amazing smoothie bike, and more.
