Council officers At the May meeting, Nick Heywood agreed to continue as Chair and Jenny Walmsley as Vice-Chair.

Policing in Caton-with-Littledale Sgt Brown of Lancashire Constabulary came to speak to the Annual Meeting in May about crime and policing in our parish and neighbouring areas. He stressed that this is a safe area to live. About 400 reports were made to the police in the last year, but many were to do with "public safety", such as missing persons, lost and found property, sheep on the road or the need for the police to help the ambulance service get access to someone's house. Then there were reports of road accidents, and traffic issues. He noted that Quernmore Road and the Scarthwaite bends were the most likely places for accidents. Anti-social behaviour reports mostly came from the Artlebeck area, and thefts mostly from the caravan park. The rural areas were most at risk of burglary, especially of expensive trailers, quad bikes and farm machinery. Some drug-related arrests had been made recently. And some shoplifting. He explained that the whole of the Lower Lune Valley has just one dedicated PC and one PCSO, but can draw on resources from the rural policing unit, and from colleagues at Lancaster and Morecambe. He stressed the importance of reporting suspicious behaviour even if no-one can attend immediately, the logs of cases are used to decide where to concentrate policing in future. And it all helps build up a fuller picture. So to report - for speeding and traffic go straight to the Lancashire Road Safety Partnership, for other issues use the Lancashire Police website or ring 101. Incidentally, you can see data about accidents on our roads by using the MARIO service - on Lancashire County Council's website. Finally, Neighbourhood Watch schemes do seem to be effective, when set up for small areas such as a street or small cluster of houses.

Play Park at Fell View Thanks to Chris Lennon, who has dealt with the rotting timbers surrounding our play park. The slopes will be seeded once the weather permits.Perimeter fencing will be installed.

The cold dry March and April turned into a hot dry May and the gardens responded with delight. Everything should be growing abundantly, but I have learned that when tomatoes are placed in the greenhouse too soon and get cold, they stop growing. This happened to some of mine and I am now hoping they pick up again soon. The beans, squashes and cabbages are thriving though. I was a bit concerned that the soil would be too dry for planting out and was very happy to find that there was quite a bit of moisture still in there, thanks to the thick layer of mulch I've been applying. This has given me confidence to water just a bit less this year and only do so when plants are visibly wilting or not growing. The fruit bushes are flowering and setting fruit, whilst the blackbirds are watching and waiting with keen interest for their share in the produce. The shelves for sharing surplus food and the seedbox are ticking over. I have planted a ridiculous number of courgettes hoping for a glut this year \bigcirc . We teamed up with the gardening club again at the Gala and I hope you found us for a chat, to see what we have been doing, and maybe even to start your own food growing adventure. 
