Road closure at Artlebeck Bridge The closure dates have been confirmed as 27 May to 2 June, while Cadent carries out preliminary investigations. The footbridge won't be affected. At the time The Link went to press, we had not received Lancashire County Council's plans for alternative routes, nor how the buses will be affected. We will post to Facebook and the website when there is news.

Footpath closure We have been notified of the temporary closure of the footpath along the Lune near the Pipe Bridge; however the landowner has given permission for walkers to use the land alongside, so it should not affect access in practice.

PlayPark at Fell View We will order more Cushionfall, to be delivered after half term. Before it can be spread, the existing surface needs to be forked over and raked. We need at least 5-6 people to do this, on Saturday 1st June. Please come along with a rake or garden fork, any time from 9am. Speed Indicator Devices (SPID) Poles for our new solar-powered SPID are now in place on the A683, and the devices will soon be installed.

Bus shelter at corner of Copy Lane and Brookhouse Road This bus shelter is to be refurbished shortly.

Buses We are pressing for improved bus services for our parish, including more evening buses and services which run directly to the hospital and the railway station, not just to the Bus Station.

Bollards With Lancashire Highways, we are investigating where bollards make access difficult or impossible for wheelchairs or mobility scooters, and looking at removal or re-siting.

Councillors Nick Heywood is continuing as Chair and Jenny Walmsley as Vice Chair. Your Parish Council needs additional councillors. If you are interested in our work do come to our next meeting, which is on Tuesday 11th June at 7pm at the Lune Valley Methodist Hub in Brookhouse. There is an open session at the start of every meeting where residents may raise issues of local concern.

Our Y6 children have worked incredibly hard during SATs week, staying calm and doing their very best every day. They enjoyed sausage and bacon sandwiches daily, which definitely made the week easier to bear!

Our Y4/5 children enjoyed an afternoon of culture when they visited the theatre in Blackpool to watch 'The Boy at the Back of the Class.' This was a culmination of the learning they had been doing in class about the plight of Ahmet, a refugee who made the dangerous journey to England. The children have written letters to the Government about refugees, as well as writing their own refugee story.

Y2/3 have also been out and about, enjoying a nature trip to Leighton Moss where they went pond dipping, bird watching and learned about the local wildlife. They were very fortunate to hear the booming of a bittern as well.

Our reception children have been learning about traditional tales, growing beans for 'Jack and the Beanstalk' and making gingerbread men for 'The Gingerbread Man.' The children enjoyed their immersive learning and produced some lovely writing about these stories.

Our KS2 dance team performed wonderfully on the stage of the Winter Gardens in the Lancashire dance finals, in front of an audience of more than 100 people. They were incredibly brave and performed with gusto! Our Y5/6 football team played brilliantly to finish 5th in the Champions League which is contested by all Lancaster and Morecambe schools – a great achievement.

We are also part of the 'Pupil parliament' which teaches our children about democracy and protected characteristics. Our Y5/6 school council members visited the pupil parliament this month and have brought some great ideas back to school.

Since the last edition of the Link, every child at Caton Primary, from as young as age four, has received some excellent first aid training from Mini First Aid. They have been taught what to do in a range of emergency situations, from performing CPR to dressing burns, and how to help someone if they are choking.

Our inter-house dodgeball competition was a great success. We saw some great dodges, catches, and most importantly, excellent sportsmanship throughout the whole day! Well done to the winners - green team. Our football team competed against ten other teams in the Lune Valley schools tournament and after playing five matches, they came home with bronze medals. They demonstrated great teamwork and resilience (winning the nervewracking semi final on penalties!). We look forward to more sporting events in the next week, including netball and cross country.

Four Year 5 pupils represented our school at the Lancaster and Morecambe schools Pupil Parliament event which was organised by the LCC Equality and Diversity Team. It focused on the protected characteristics of Sex and Gender in the Equality Act 2010. They took part in various workshops, activities and discussions and learnt a lot about stereotypes and how they can affect our perceptions of people. The children then presented what they had learnt to their friends back in school so everyone could benefit from their learning. Well done to Harris, Harrison, Hollie and George!

KS2 pupils had a visit from the Health Protection Service to learn all about hand hygiene. They learnt how to properly wash their hands, the causes of sickness bugs, how important it is to catch a sneeze, and just how easy it is to pass on germs via a hand shake!

Class 3 shared their history learning with the whole school and parents in their excellent assembly. We heard about the Roman invasion of Britain, Boudicca's rebellion, how the Romans developed trade and the technological advances that they introduced. It was a very interesting and well-presented assembly. Well done, Class 3!

In early May, our Infinity pre school children got their first taste of 'big school' when our current Reception class planned, prepared and hosted a superhero party for them. It was a super afternoon - lots of fun was had by all and the carrot cakes that Reception baked were a big hit! 
