COUNCILLORS - At the May meeting, Nick Heywood was elected Chair with Jenny Walmsley continuing as Vice Chair. Emma Frobisher was co-opted as a councillor. After that meeting Mark Skeldon stood down as a councillor. We are grateful to him for his service on the Parish Council, especially on the Poors Land Charity. We do now have another vacancy; any local resident who is interested in joining the council should contact the Parish Clerk in the first instance.

GRASS CUTTING - The Parish Council was disappointed to hear that this year Lancaster City Council will only cut the grass every four weeks instead of every two. We hope that get back to a more frequent cut next year.

PLAY PARK -Replacing the seat on the zip wire is proving more difficult and expensive than expected; we're investigating cost effective options.

OVERHEAD POWER LINES - The Forest of Bowland AONB has some funds available to replace overhead power lines with underground lines. Which do you find most unsightly in our area? Let the Parish Clerk know - please include photos and explain exactly which area you mean.

FLAG AT THE WAR MEMORIAL - For many years, Station Garage has stored the flag, and ensured it is flown when required, most recently to mark the death of the Duke of Edinburgh. A big thank you to the team at Station Garage for doing this! In future the flag will be stored at the Victoria Institute. The Parish Council is investigating buying a new flag - the current one has been in service a long time.

NEXT PARISH COUNCIL MEETING will be held on 8th June. It may be possible to hold an in-person meeting; if not it will be by Zoom again. Contact the Parish Clerk for the latest information.

POLICING AND SPEEDING - Speeding is a major concern for many residents. We can all report roads where speeding is an issue. Please do it on the correct Lancashire Highways site: https://lancsroadsafety.co.uk/submit-concern/. If there are enough reports over a period from different residents, then Highways will work with the police , and speed checks and investigations will take place. If you see vehicles parked dangerously, perhaps near the zebra crossing or elsewhere, do take a photo as evidence and then inform the police by dialling 101 in the first instance. Some residents have felt that the police are slow to respond to incidents in rural areas, especially anti-social behaviour and vandalism. Our local PCSOs say that they do now have more staff in the rural policing team, and hope to respond more rapidly.

### LUNE VALLEY SWIFT GROUP

Our Swifts are back! Despite being delayed by the northerly winds of early May, Swifts have now returned from southern Africa to our villages to breed. And thanks to so many of you installing nest boxes, there are now more locations for them to do so. But the more nest boxes we can provide the better, so If you would like advice on how to do this, please get in touch.

If you are installing your own Swift next boxes there are a few golden rules: they should be on east or north facing walls (on south and west facing walls, boxes get too warm and chicks can die from overheating); and they need to be a minimum of 5-metres above the ground with a clear flyway in front (no obstacles such trees or buildings close by).

Over the next two months, our little group of volunteers will be doing evening surveys to gather records of where Swifts are nesting, so we can help protect these sites. Do let us know if you see Swifts coming and going from a nest site or flying low around buildings (often screaming as they fly). lunevalleyswifts@gmail.com
