COUNCILLORS - At its May meeting, the Parish Council elected Nick Heywood as Chair and Jenny Walmsley as Vice-Chair. If you are interested in the work of the Parish Council, you are welcome to attend one of our meetings. LITTER BIN REPLACEMENT - The Parish Council is ordering a replacement litter bin for the layby on Quernmore Road (between Broadacre and Gresgarth). Lancaster City Council will empty it as part of their regular round. We are considering which other bins need replacing, ideally with larger bins.

PLANTER AT WAVECREST - This planter has served us well for a long time, but is now falling apart. We're getting another wooden one made.

OAK TREE AT THE FISHSTONES - A home within the parish has been found for the sapling there at the moment, which is growing from a secondary shoot. The work to prepare the ground for a sturdy replacement tree and repair the railings will be under way soon.

PLAY PARK - The quotation for the repairs needed for the Play Park at Fell View has come in from the original builders, and is too expensive. The Parish Council is looking for other ways to get the work done, using local contractors wherever possible. And we will need help from volunteers right away, to get the ground weeded and prepared for a new dressing of Cushionfloor.

The next workparty is planned for Saturday 10th June. Please come any time between 9am and 11am and bring garden forks and gloves. Rakes and brooms could be useful. If you live near Fell View and can bring a green bin for the weeds, that would be very helpful.

CATON-WITH-LITTLEDALE NEIGHBOURHOOD DEVELOPMENT PLAN

The referendum on the Neighbourhood Plan was held on Thursday 4th May. Turnout was 39%. 733 people voted yes, 136 no, and there were 14 spoilt ballots.

Quite a number of people already grow their own food and we would love for more people to connect with us, and for those who have not grown food before to give it a try. We are supporting the village community orchard plans and are ready to help with the planting and maintenance when these plans are finalised. For anyone who struggles to pick their own fruit bushes or trees, we are more than keen to come and help pick and stop the fruit going to waste.

Earlier this year we hosted a composting workshop to learn more about recycling our kitchen and garden waste into valuable compost for making healthy soil and growing good crops. We were introduced to the idea of community composting, for example to share a compost bin with neighbours. We would love to hear from anyone interested or already doing this. How could you get involved? Do you grow your own veggies and you want to join our chat group? Would you like help to get started in your own garden? Would you like help with harvesting your fruit? Are you interested to learn more about preserving food to last through winter? Would you like to share your garden and allow someone else to come and grow some veggies?
