GROW CATON

This time of year is so exciting! The broad beans and onions have germinated and now it's time to sow the next batch of hardy veggies: cauliflower, radish, turnip, celery, kohl rabi, spinach and a number of herbs. The potatoes are nicely chitting away and will be planted later this month. We have had the annual chat about compost on our group and from the various options I have decided to mulch with well rotted manure again. The seed swap box is back at the institute ready for action. We will keep an eye on it and make sure that the seeds swapped have a viable date, nothing is more disappointing than when seeds don't germinate. The shelves for swapping veggie seedlings (and later on surplus produce) will be back at 75 Brookhouse Road by the time you read this. The garden share at the moment is well balanced between growers and owners. If there are any people looking for a space to grow, or if anyone would like to see their garden used (again) then do get in touch and we will do our best to match you up with each other. We really hope that lots of veggies will be grown in the village this year. If you don't know where to start, then do get in touch and we will help get you set off. Some salad in a planter or a teepee of beans make a very easy first attempt. CATON PRIMARY SCHOOL

As the weather has improved, we have been taking our learning outside more, making the most of our beautiful grounds. Reception and Class 2 had fun taking part in the Big Garden Bird Watch, making bird feeders to attract the birds and then observing lots of visitors! The older children have been learning maths outside and the Eco Committee has been busy preparing our raised beds ready for sowing. As always, our children love their weekly Forest School sessions in our very own forest.

We have some more interesting topics for the children this term. Reception Class are learning all about animals and are looking forward to their trip to Blackpool Zoo later this month. In Geography, Class 2 is learning about the United Kingdom and, having previously compared Caton and Bunessan on the Isle of Mull, they are now comparing Lancaster and Preston. In Science, Class 3 has been experimenting with sound and investigating pitch. They strummed different types of guitars and created their own, as well as designing a new musical instrument for Beyonce! The classroom was quite noisy! In DT, Class 4 have been developing their knowledge of structures before building their very own wooden truss bridge. They investigated how to reinforce bridge structures made out of cardboard; built spaghetti truss bridges; produced carefully drawn designs involving 90 and 45 degree angles; made their own set squares; and began measuring their wooden struts. All this before they have even handled a saw! Class 4 are getting very excited in advance of their residential trip to London later this month. We will let you know how it went in next month's Link.

At the end of January, our school organised a performing arts day at the Victoria Institute for pupils from twelve local primary schools to enjoy.
