HEDGES - Thank you to the people who have cut back their hedges recently. If there are problem trees or hedges - which obstruct footpaths or roads - please contact the Parish Clerk, ideally with a photograph as well as the address. Lancashire County Council may get involved and in extreme cases will do the necessary cutting back and charge the property owner.

HORNBY ROAD CAR PARK - The Parish Council rents this car park from Lancashire County Council. The annual rent is increasing, to £500 a year. The PC hopes the surface can be improved, and the parking bay markings refreshed.

SMALL GRANTS - The Parish Council can give small grants to village organisations. Most recently it has helped with the maintenance of the parish burial ground, at St Paul's Church.

It's been great to welcome new members during 2021, and we are hoping to resume our in-person group meetings this year from April onwards. We are a friendly, informal group, so please do come along if you are interested in finding out more about how to help our Swifts. We meet on the second Tuesday of each month at 7.30pm in the Station pub. Over the summer we will continue to carry out surveys of breeding Swifts around local villages (done simply by walking areas on warm evenings). And we'll continue to provide advice to home-owners on how to protect and create Swift nest sites. CATON WITH LITTLEDALE PLAY PARK ACTION GROUP

Our survey 'Have your say' on outdoor facilities for our community aimed to find out what we would like, and where. It offers evidence for future plans. What did it find? First it showed how much you use and value our beautiful local countryside for informal and social leisure. So the survey evidence emphasises how important to you is protecting and improving access to the countryside and green spaces. (Organised sport was for a minority).

Secondly, the survey showed 'what more' may be on our community 'wish list' for informal leisure for different age groups, in what location - and, if popular, improve health and well-being with free access for all. It showed sufficient support to move on to the 'next stage' of detailed design consultations with user age groups for the following: a BMX trail ('pump track'); scooter; skateboard facility; for a fitness ('trim trail'); for a shelter, outdoor table tennis table, small toddler items such as bouncers/springers; for a large slide on a mound at Fell View Play Park; an all weather facility at Caton Primary School; teen multichallenge equipment. Support was also noted for more: open green spaces; paths away from traffic; wildlife habitats; trees; picnic benches.

Thirdly, your comments on what should be considered in choosing a location for facilities generated a 'tick box' list. The Millennium path easily scored top for smaller items. The land adjacent to both churches would also be popular if availability became an option. The lack of any facilities in Brookhouse was frequently noted, with site availability the main constraint. (But what could be done? Identify small 'pockets' of land? Or maybe the Parish Council seek land to lease or purchase?)

Ideas for moving forward emerge from the report! If you are interested, the report is available from the facebook page of Caton with Littledale Play Park Action Group and hopefully now on the village website.
