For a while now I have been aware that we are a fair distance to our nearest Defibrillator in Brookhouse so I am fundraising for a public access defibrillator for Caton Green, I'm delighted to say that the directors of Hillcroft Nursing Home have agreed to its installation on the front wall of their building which is central to the village and will be easily accessible at any time of day or night. Once it is installed, we will be provided with training on its use.

In just two weeks I have been pledged £1215 by my friends and family. (£1500 is needed for the initial purchase.) They are supporting me to complete a 25k Trail run from Keswick in May. You can search on Facebook for 'Defibrillator for Caton Green' to support me - or if you would rather not do this through Facebook you can donate in person at Marybank Farm (Cheques to Mrs P Griffiths) or contact me to arrange another method. Any donation will be very gratefully received as there are additional ongoing costs for maintenance and replacement of pads etc.

PLANS FOR CYCLING AND WALKING IN LANCASHIRE

Lancashire County Council wants to join up the gaps in our existing network of footpaths and cycle routes and provide safer, direct and more convenient routes. Working in partnership with Blackpool Council, they are developing Local Cycling and Walking Infrastructure Plans, providing long term solutions for our future cycling and walking networks throughout Lancashire, including around Lancaster. They are asking for feedback from across the county on current cycling and walking provision. They want to know what the gaps are in the network and what facilities would enable people to walk and cycle more.

The survey will be available on the council's website until 5 May 2022. Additional design and feasibility work will be needed to take any of the proposed schemes forward. LUNE VALLEY SWIFT GROUP

Its May at last, the month that sees our Swifts return after a 6000-mile flight from southern Africa. Keep an eye out for their high-speed aerobatics where insects are plentiful, such as along the river. And we'll soon see them flying low around buildings, staking their claims for nest sites once again.

As many of their nest sites have been lost, installing nest boxes is one of the best ways you can help our Swifts, and there are a few golden rules for doing so: boxes should be on east or north facing walls (or elsewhere if in shade all day) to avoid chicks dying from overheating; and they need to be a minimum of 4-metres above the ground with a clear flyway in front -no obstacles such trees or buildings close by.

We will be at the Caton Gala this month, so come and see us. And over the summer we will continue surveys of breeding Swifts and providing advice to home-owners on how to protect nest sites. We can also supply nest boxes at cost for £24. So please get in touch if you would like a nest box, some advice or to join our friendly group of lunevalleyswifts@gmail.com

CROOK O LUNE CARAVAN PARK

Development Forest of Bowland AONB. REF 22/00341/FUL

This article is to raise public awareness that the Crook O Lune caravan park has applied for planning permission for the siting of 19 Caravans. Planning reference 22/00341/FUL .This is despite the first application being quashed by the courts and the second application being refused. Nothing materially has changed. Natural England have designated EAGLE'S NEST WOOD to be ANCIENT

The new development will impact on the Parish in the following way:

- 1) The Lancaster development plan seeks to protect the AONB and states that suitable caravan site provision already exists.
- 2) Visual amenity will be affected for road users and local path users. Residents and visitors of the local area will be greeted by a caravan site at the gateway to the Forest of Bowland adjacent to the A683. This is not what the AONB promotes or deserves.
- 3) The woodland on the site is designated ANCIENT. Critically, changing the drainage, landscape, and not to mention the increase in pollution will result in the destruction of precious ancient and veteran trees and the wildlife they support.
- 4) The development is touted as a sustainable development. Sustainable developments are not propped up at the cost to local communities. The Sites 19 caravans will take from the local community in the form of services (Caton surgery, Schools ect) without payment in the form of Council tax. The community is left to subsidise profits.
- 5) Increase in sewerage from an area that already suffers from long term sewerage issues.
- 6) Road safety on the A683 due to the access and egress to the site. Increased standing water adjacent to the site and increased surface water running across the A683 poses a danger to road users. The site access has no pavement and is a single track blind road. This is extremely dangerous to pedestrians and impossible for disabled people to access.

It is important to protect the natural environment and encourage bio diversity for future generations not damage it for unsustainable development where there is no gain for the public only short term profit for the developer.

In addition the site has been badly damaged due to breach of planning conditions from the previous applications with many habitats destroyed.

The actual site is within the Parish of Quernmore, but some of the effects will be felt in Caton with Littledale.
