New councillor: We are pleased that Tony Rei has been co-opted as a parish councillor.

Play Park We need someone to carry out regular maintenance, including minor repairs and raking the sand and Cushionfall. Please contact the Clerk for more information. And thank you to Lancaster City Council for replacing the litter bins.

Reporting faults The "Love Clean Streets" app is great for reporting potholes, blocked drains, faullty street lights, fly-tipping and fallen trees blocking roads and pavements. You can customise it to Lancashire Council, who are responsible for highways here.

Tree Planting The Coronation Living Heritage Fund has awarded the Parish Council over £700 for fruit trees to plant in our area. We will need volunteers soon, to help plant them. If you would like to get involved, please contact Judy Powell on 771154.

Oak tree at junction of Copy Lane and Brookhouse Road The Parish Council is looking at rebuilding the low wall around the tree, or finding another solution for the area. Our thanks to a local resident who has promised to help with the rebuilding costs.

Bus shelter at Copy Lane Thanks to Chris Lennon for cleaning and repainting the shelter. And for repainting bollards and repairing gates.

Greenway The "windows" in the hedges have been cut out again.

Bus services The Parish Council takes part in the Lancaster Bus Users' Group, and is taking up complaints about the number of buses which do not run.

Poors Land In 1724, Edward Fincham left land to be used to benefit people in need living in this parish. The land is let out for grazing and fishing, and the proceeds are distributed annually by the Parish Council. This year the Parish Council has a supplement to the Poors Land fund, in the form of a donation from The Link. These small grants are distributed every December, in time for Christmas. The amounts given are usually around £50-£100.. Application forms are available from 1st November and have to be returned by 30th November. The forms may be collected from the Cottam Room at the Victoria Institute or obtained directly from the Parish Clerk.

Road safety will be a major topic at the November meeting of the Parish Council (Tuesday 12 November, 7pm, Lune Valley Methodist Hub). Do send in your comments before then. A reminder: Road safety is a major issue for many residents, and the Parish Council wants to take our proposals to Lancashire County Council. Our ideas so far are: the creation of a "20 mph zone" throughout Caton and Brookhouse; pedestrian crossings, speed limits and further traffic calming beyond Caton on Lancaster Road, Hornby Road and Quernmore Road; a 30 mph speed limit in Caton Green and onwards to Brookhouse; improvements to and around the mini-roundabout at the centre of Caton; making Holme Lane a No Through Road; a full review of the provision and quality of pavements throughout the built-up areas; consideration of making pavement parking illegal on some streets. Next we need comments from local people. You can collect a printed copy of our draft paper from the Victoria Institute (Cottam Room) or the Lune Valley Methodist Hub. Online it is on our website links to it from our Facebook pages too. Or contact the Parish Clerk for a copy. Comments on paper can be left at the VI or LVMH, or emailed to the Parish Clerk.
