**Village upkeep** Thank you to the people who help keep our parish looking attractive. Trimmed hedges, flower-filled gardens - all lifts the spirit! Recent achievements include the thorough weeding and sweeping at The Fishstones, carried out by a parish councillor. Thank you too to the residents who flagged the dumping in the Artlebeck, and to those who cleared it so quickly. **Public toilet** The Parish Council and the Victoria Institute trustees have decided that the public toilet outside the VI can continue to open from 7am to 7pm, 7 days a week. This is funded by your parish council.

Vandalism at Copy Lane bus stop In recent months the PC has spent almost £1000 on getting this bus shelter cleaned, painted and repaired, and then the "glass" replaced after four panels were smashed. Given that our income from the parish precept is less than £40,000, this has an impact on what else we can do to keep the village tidy, and provide services for our residents.

**Play park Fundraising** is under way for a replacement roundabout - the mechanism on the current one is damaged despite several previous repairs. We are also investigating funding to install the planned table tennis table there.

**Speed enforcement on Caton Green Road** After complaints from the PC and local residents, Lancashire Police monitored speeds on Caton Green Road during the evening rush hour on 8th September. Most drivers observed the 30mph speed limit, but some were speeding. These drivers will be offered a speed awareness course, fixed penalty points or a court summons.

**Footpath closure** The public footpath starting at Hawthorn Close is expected to remain closed until March while building work continues.

Planning application for housing off Quernmore Road Thank you to the residents who came to the September PC meeting to present their concerns about this development. The PC decided to object. Grounds for objection included flooding, especially onto Quernmore Road and along Escowbeck; highways; insufficient affordable housing; expansion of the village beyond its current boundaries; need for it to be treated as a major development within the Forest of Bowland National Landscape. However the PC welcomed the provision of smaller, less expensive homes rather than large executive houses, and the incorporation of some environment-friendly features into the scheme. The decision on the application will be taken by Lancaster City Council Planning Committee, possibly in November.

#### Next PC meeting Tuesday 14 October 7pm at the Victoria Institute.

Policing in our parish Lancashire Police brought a roadshow to Brookhouse on 10 September, with four officers and examples of crime prevention kit. A number of residents raised concerns. Two of our parish councilors attended too. Main topics raised were anti-social behaviour, flytipping, graffiti and drugs. Road safety, speeding, illegal parking and ebikes were also discussed. The officers stressed how important it is to report all incidents of crime and anti-social behaviour. Report online or by ringing 101. Speeding and bad driver behaviour needs to be reported to Lancashire Road Safety Partnership, which has its own website but does not appear to have a separate phone number, so use 101. Installing CCTV can be worthwhile as it can provide evidence, make people feel more secure and may get a reduction on your house insurance. The officers also helped vulnerable residents with advice on personal alarms.

Fruit has been amazing with apples, plums and damsons dripping off the trees and being shared far and wide. Our group has been discovering new ways for preserving from damson jam, jelly, fool, cake to fruit leather. The community orchard has produced one plum and one pear, which is great for its first harvest. The seed swap box has come home for winter and will get a good sort through. Once the last of the harvest is gathered we will mulch down the beds for winter and enjoy the break nature gives us. 
