CATON WITH LITTLEDALE NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

In 2015 the Parish Council decided a Neighbourhood Plan was needed to shape development in our village. This was particularly important here as Lancaster City Council had designated Caton and Brookhouse as sustainable settlements (Policy DM42 in the Lancaster Development Management Plan adopted 2014). Sustainable settlements are villages which are a focus for growth outside urban areas and so the Lancaster plan may direct development towards them. The Parish Council asked for volunteers to form a Steering Group. With advice from Kirkwells Ltd (town planning consultants), the Steering Group has worked on our neighbourhood plan. The Group has already held several 'drop in' events and asked residents to complete both a questionnaire and on-line survey. These responses were very helpful as they informed the decisions made as we drew up and developed the draft plan.

The Steering Group intends to hold two further 'drop-in' events to allow local residents to comment on aspects of the plan.

The two main areas we need your comments on are:

Designation of Green Spaces. These have to be demonstrably special to the area and once designated there is protection against development. The Green Spaces we have designated are:- Millenium Track; Station Field; The Bowling Green, Caton; Beckside; Fell View Playground; Parish Woodland, The Glen, Caton; Sports Field, Caton Community School.

We have also drawn detailed boundaries to create and protect the Area of Separation between Caton and Brookhouse on both sides of Brookhouse Road.

Development Sites. As Lancaster City Council has decided Caton and Brookhouse are sustainable settlements, we have to have a neighbourhood plan which addresses the questions of where, how much and what type of housing development is accepted.

In order to establish which sites could be used for development we used the Lancaster City Council Strategic Housing and Employment Land Availability Assessment (SHELAA) recently updated in 2018.

There were several sites identified, mostly in Caton. We commissioned an independent Landscape and Visual impact Survey to look at all the sites individually and to assess the overall impact on the villages of cumulative development. We have also commissioned a wildlife survey for the same sites.

However we will be using strict criteria to attempt to control the density, design and other factors, such as mitigating the impact. We are very aware that Caton and Brookhouse sit within the Forest of Bowland AONB and therefore 'all development is expected to conform to a very high standard of design, to be in keeping with local landscape character and should seek to conserve and enhance the AONB's natural beauty.'

The sites which are emerging from our independent professional advice are:-

Land at Mill Lane: Land to the South of Hawthorn Close; Land to west of Quernmore Road

ROAD SAFETY IN THE VILLAGE - Please remember that most roads in the village have a 20mph speed limit. On the A683 and Quernmore Road the limit is 30mph, and the boundaries on the A683 are expected to be extended soon. The Parish Council hopes to deploy more speed indicator devices (SPiDs) to advise drivers of their speed on our roads. We're asking for action over the pedestrian crossing on Hornby Road, to make it easier to see from a distance. If there has been a dangerous incident on our roads, please tell the police at once. However if you are concerned about a particular junction, please contact Lancashire County Council as they are our Highways Authority. Their phone number is 0300 123 6701. ELECTRIC CAR CHARGING POINT - A charging point is under consideration for the car park on Hornby Road, next to Boots.

HEDGES - This is a good time to look carefully at hedges, trees and bushes around your garden. Do they overhang the pavement? Are they gradually growing over a public footpath? Do they make it hard for drivers to see round a corner or come out of a junction? Can people in wheelchairs or pushing buggies get past without going into the road? Please plan to cut back hedges, trees and bushes this autumn. They should be in line with the boundary between your house and the pavement/footpath/road. Thank you!

PARKING ON PAVEMENTS - Many local residents complain about cars parked on pavements. At present it is not illegal in this area, although there are proposals to bring in an automatic £70 fine nationwide. However even now the police can intervene because "parking a vehicle on the pavement could lead to an offence of obstruction being committed – this could result in a fixed penalty notice being issued to offending vehicle/s." . So please don't park on the pavement!

BENCHES IN BUS SHELTERS - The Parish Council is looking into how to provide seating at bus stops, benches where possible.

DEFIBRILLATOR AT BROOKHOUSE - The Parish Council is working with St Paul's School PTA to buy a defibrillator and storage case which would be fitted outside in the school car park, where it will be always accessible.

FELL VIEW PLAY PARK - The Parish Council is considering a major refurbishment of the Play Park, probably taking place next year

LUNE VALLEY SWIFT GROUP

It's been a busy summer for the group. During national Swift Awareness Week in July the Caton Institute kindly allowed us to set up a stand with information about Swifts and our conservation work, with a live link to a Swift nestcam! We also led an evening guided walk to watch the summer spectacle of Swift screaming parties flying low about buildings and darting in and out of nest sites. Group members have also been carrying out surveys around the villages throughout the summer to identify where our Swifts are nesting. A huge thank you to all those that have taken part.

Our Swifts departed for Africa in early August, to return again to nest here next May, but in the meantime we have much to do! We are now buying Swift nest boxes for installation on community buildings, as well as other resources to make available to householders keen to help nesting Swifts, and we will also be piecing together a picture of the key areas for Swifts in our villages from the survey data collected. 

Once connected, a sum of money is available to the householder or business that could be used to cover the cost of incidental works in getting B4RN from your property boundary into the property. The funding we receive covers the cost of materials, employing contractors for road crossings and other civil engineering works. We still rely on volunteers for the easier digging works.

Action required - To get this rolling we need everyone on Route 7 covered by the postcodes above to register for this scheme – even if you've registered or expressed an interest in getting B4RN in the past. Please do it again. Registration does not commit you to anything but helps us understand how many businesses we have and what interest we have from the community.

Please register as a business if you have business premises or if you run a business from home in one of the Route 7 postcodes otherwise register as a domestic homeowner.
