GROW CATON

Summer has been busy as usual, and it's been lovely eating fresh food from the gardens. The plants have had a great season with warm temperatures and plenty of rain and should have done well. If anyone knows what causes cucumbers to be fine one day and dead the next, then please do let us know so that we can avoid that next year. The heavy wind in July did some damage to the beans that were not staked well, but they are still thriving. Making better frames will be a priority for next season. We've had clouds of cabbage whites in our garden and the resulting caterpillars to deal with, all part of the insect life which has been abundant this year. I wonder if that is what has helped bumper crops of fruit in some places. We've shared lots of gooseberries and apples, and the plums and damsons are looking good too. Do keep an eye on the white shelves for taking and sharing surplus with neighbours. A good number of us joined the gardening club trip to Bridgewater and came home with fresh inspirations from the walled kitchen garden. 


